They are developing their little sensory garden, which is used as a learning tool throughout the school, with lots of herbs, a place where the students experience all the senses: sight, hearing, touch, smell & taste.

The middle classes are concentrating on creating a 'Fairy Garden' a place of wonder & magic for our students. They were assisted by some of our parents . Students used their art /craft work to enhance their garden space.

Another group are creating a Bug Hotel with a host of wonderful surprises.

The Senior students are busy with their vegetable raised bed. This year they have planted lettuce, potatoes, brussel sprouts, tomotoes and strawberries as part of their horticulture programme. The senior group also decided to create a special 'Henry Ford Centenary Garden 'to celebrate 100 years of Henry Ford in Cork. Using only recycled materials, students designed a replica of the Model T., window boxes and a host of other surprises e.g. a beautiful swan moulded out of an old tyre and used as a flower bed. The whole school is actively involved in the Gardening Project & take great pride in our wonderful community.


